Following on in the great tradition of Rodger McPhail's bestselling 'Open Season' and 'Fishing Season', 'Game Season' combines wonderful anecdotes and observations by the foremost country author, John Humphreys, covering all the main game species (grouse, partridge, pheasant, wildfowl, pigeon, rabbit, hare, venison and trout and salmon) with delicious and stimulating recipes by his wife, Angela Humphreys, author of the classic and still best-selling 'Game Season'. Illustrated throughout by Rodger McPhail's specially commissioned paintings which both interpret the text and show the glory of the species, this is a book that will be treasured by generations as a classic record of the British countryside.

John Humphreys takes us on a ramble through the countryside in this charming book that contains a mixed bag of recollections, reminiscences, recitations and recipes. Chapters cover the pheasant and wildfowl as well as hare, rabbit, deer, trout and other game. Humphrey's wife, Angela, has concocted recipes using the animal or bird as the main ingredients, so readers can enjoy tales of rabbits before indulging in chilli con coney, or try out venison terrine once they have become endeared to the story of a stag. More adventurous cooks can crow about baking rook pie or pike 'n' prawns. Painting lifelike animals is something Rodger McPhail has got down to a fine art, and the illustrations in this book are no exception - running hare, crouching partridge, drifting salmon or goose on the wing - every depiction is detailed and animated. This combination of stories, recipes and illustrations makes for a fascinating read; like every game season, you wont want it to end.

Rodger McPhail is an internationally acclaimed wildlife artist whose previous very successful books include 'Open Season' and 'Fishing Season'.

The text is interesting enough and provides a bit of light bed time reading, I'm not in any way qualified to comment on the recipes; my main reason for purchasing this book was the prospect of another set of fine illustrations by R McPhail. I have to say I was a bit disappointed with them; one or two are very good but in general they are not outstanding, most are simply what you would expect from any standard book illustrator and not from a first-rate sporting artist.

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Rodger McPhail was born in Lancashire in 1953. He is an internationally-renowned wildlife artist. His love and enthusiasm for the countryside and its birds and animals are evident in his work. Rodger has illustrated over thirty books and he also produces cartoons, caricatures, portraits and stage sets. He lives in the Lune Valley in Lancashire with his wife, Cecilia. They have two sons, Gavin and Alastair.

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
