Despite the 'SAS' title, this is a great book on driving and motoring. It's packed full of useful tips. The sections on driving agree with what you'll read in Roadcraft. (Although Roadcraft has a bit more detail on driving.) However, this book covers a much broader range of topics, from maintainance to security, than the usual advanced driving books. Obviously, for those who are interested, there are the expected bits on hijack evasion. I imagine this book could make a great present for someone.

I have been 12 years in the military and I found this book useful both for my civilian car and for military trucks. Could be useful also to professional drivers and fleet managers.
